New sponsorship scheme

National Council of Social Service (NCSS), with the support of the Ministry for Community Development, Youth and Sports, introduced the Social Work Associate Training Sponsorship this year for students who have gained admission to the new Diploma programme in Social Sciences (Social Work) at Nanyang Polytechnic. The sponsorship is for the three-year course duration on a full-time basis and the package includes support for tuition fees, other compulsory fees and an allowance for books and reference materials. This is part of NCSS' efforts in attracting new talent to the social service sector. The first batch of 10 successful applicants will be awarded the scholarship at a ceremony on 20 July 2010 at Nanyang Polytechnic.
